



First Communion

ATTIRE: We do expect the children to be dressed in nice church clothing (no jeans, sneakers, etc). Nothing can be carried up to receive Communion so please leave all rosaries, bibles, etc at home or in the car. Students cannot leave anything in the classrooms as the classrooms will be locked once Mass begins.



BOYS: Please wear a dark colored suit or sport coat with a shirt and tie, with khakis or nice dark dress pants.



GIRLS: Traditionally, girls will wear a white dress but this is not required. Girls may also wear a skirt with a nice top. Gloves are optional; please remove them before receiving Communion. Communion Veils are optional. It can be chilly in November so, if the dress has spaghetti straps, girls will need to wear a sweater or shawl.
