Effective March 15, 2017, Archbishop Kurtz assigned Steve Marks as a deacon to St. Albert the Great parish. Deacon Steve and his wife Marcia recently moved here from Clarkston, Michigan. They are both originally from this area and have family here but after college lived in Anderson Indiana for 10 years and later in Michigan for 35 years. Deacon Steve was ordained for the Archdiocese of Detroit in 2000 after preparation at Sacred Heart Major Seminary.

Growing up, Deacon Steve & Marcia attended St. Athanasius/DeSales and St. Rita/Angela Merici respectively. Deacon Steve graduated in Electrical Engineering from Purdue in 1973 and Marcia from St Joseph as a Registered Nurse in 1971. Deacon Steve is now retired after 38 years from General Motors and Marcia from the Detroit Archdiocese after first working as a labor & delivery nurse and then in faith formation at St Kieran Parish.

In addition to serving in succession at St Kieran, St Daniel and Christ the Redeemer parishes, Deacon Steve has also been heavily involved in jail ministry for the last 22 years in Oakland County, Michigan. While assisting at Mass on the weekends and performing other diaconal ministries at St. Albert the Great when available, Deacon Steve's primary focus of ministry will be to serve, encourage and be in community with incarcerated brothers and sisters and their families across the Archdiocese of Louisville.

Deacon Steve and Marcia like to cruise, travel with family and visit or host their children and grandchildren whenever the opportunity arises. (They currently have 8 children and 17 grandchildren scattered across 5 states.) Deacon Steve still likes to play basketball as his version of physical therapy.
